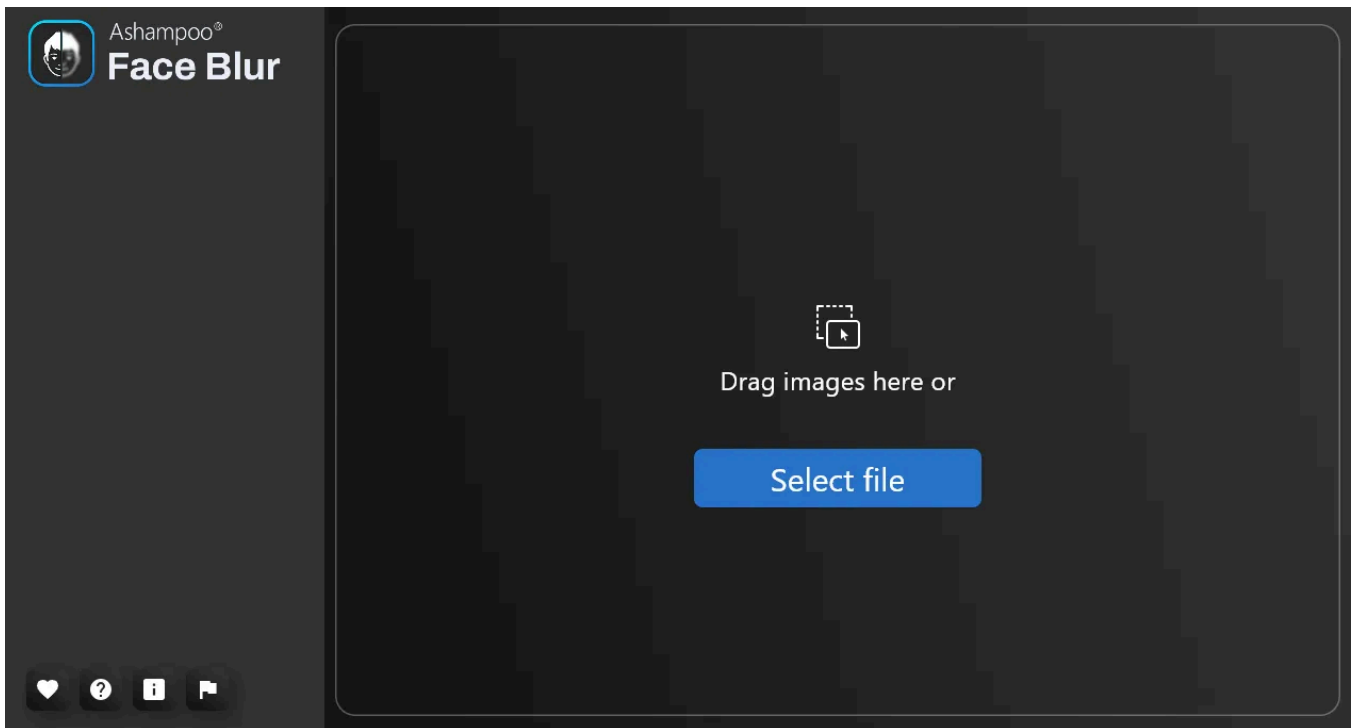

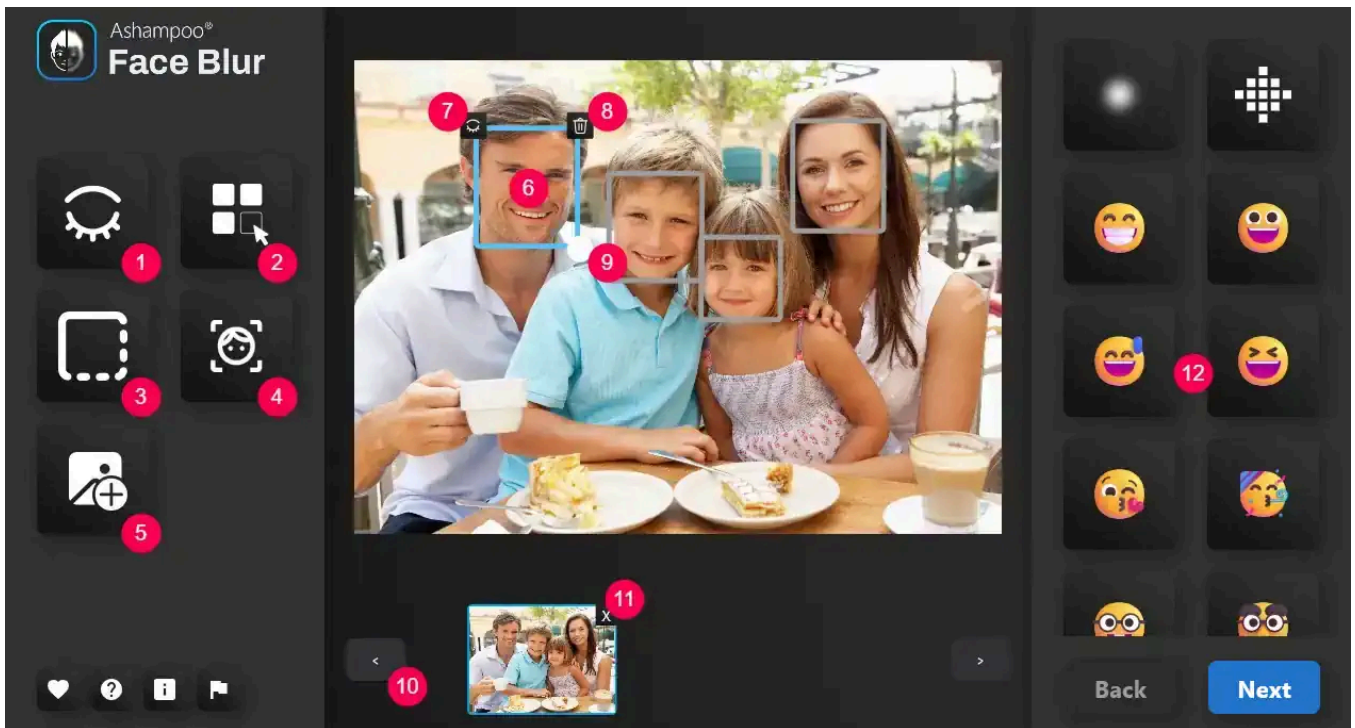

1. Select images



Drag the files into the application window or use the button to select them via the system file chooser.

2. Edit images



The program auto-marks faces during loading.

2.1 Selection tools


1: Hides/Shows the markers. Associated effects always remain visible.

2: Selects all markers. Click into an empty space in the image to clear your current selection.

3: Creates additional markers. Left-click into the image to create a marker at the mouse position.

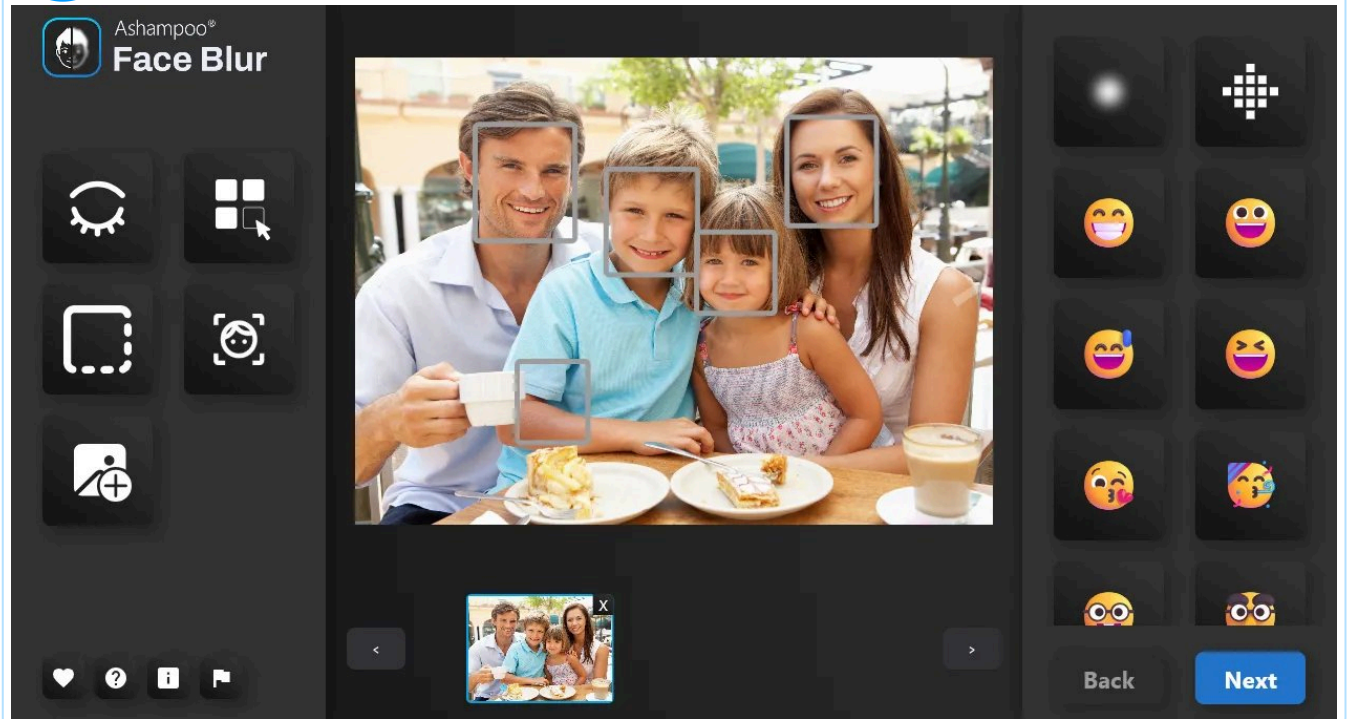

2.2 Image view

7: Hides the selection. Associated effects remain visible.

8: Removes the current effect from the marker.

9: Drag the circle to resize a marker.



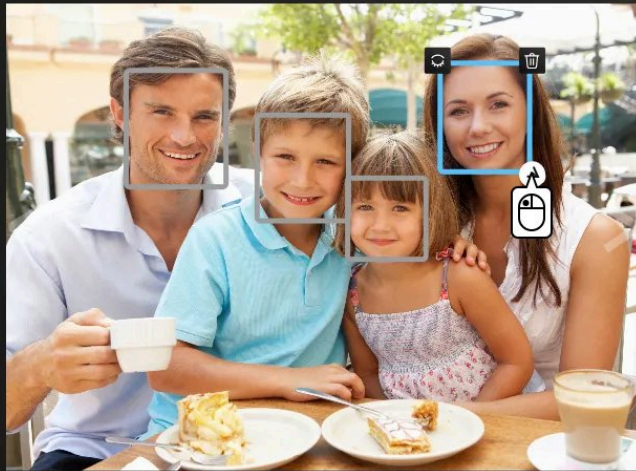

3. Export images



The program creates a dedicated "Faceblur" folder for each export in the selected output folder. If a "Faceblur" folder already exists, the new folder will carry a sequence number e.g., "Faceblur_2".

Only selected images will be exported. Click an image to select/deselect it. Use the Tabs to auto-select images.
